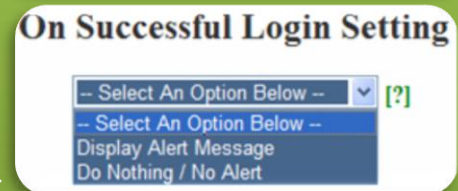
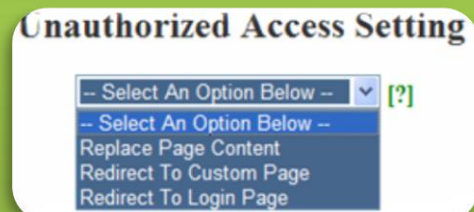
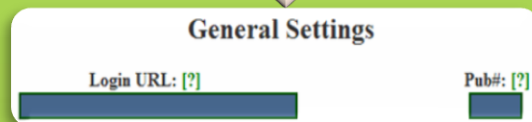
Step 1 - Create a Password Dialog Box

1. Create an account or Login to Bravenet and sign up for Password Protect
2. Customize your login in box and copy the copy paste code
3. Open Notepad and paste the code as is.
4. Save the file as login_page.htm
5. Upload file to the document gallery on your website, and create a link to it on one of your page, for example your home page.





Step 2 – Generate Code to Protect Page

1. Open the Password Gate Generator – [Click Here](#)
2. Enter login URL – Location of the file created in Step 1 (/documents/login_page.htm), and Pup#, which can be found by looking at the code in Step 1 or by looking at the address bar when you are logged into Bravenet. 
3. Choose an Unauthorized Access Setting, best way is redirect to Login Page.
4. Select a Successful Login Setting
5. Generate and Copy Code
6. Paste the code on the page/s you wish to protect.
7. You can also create a logout option – [Click Here](#), which can create a text link which will logout the user.



Step 3 – Setting up the Passwords in Bravenet

1. If you are not logged into Bravenet, Login and under Webtools go to Password Protect, once in the Password Protect Manager click Manage Accounts.  **manage accounts**
Add new users and passwords
2. Scroll Down to Add New User Account and enter a Username, Password, and the Url to the protected Page, this is the page in step 2 where you pasted the code.



Add New User Account

You currently have 6 of 50 allowed protected pages. To add a new account, enter a username, password, and URL of the page to protect below:


Remember, you cannot have two users with the same name.

Depending what you need you can have all the accounts reference the same page or you can have the accounts reference different pages, just make sure you paste the Protect code on each page.



Step 4 – General Settings and Misc.

1. (Only if you are not using the Pro version) In the Password Protect Manager, click General Settings. Select show ads in a Popup Window, this way if the end user is using a Popup blocker they will not see the ads.



Ad Serving

Select how you want ads to be displayed to users of your Password Protect. Pro accounts will not display ads.
NOTE: The Bravenet Hosting service does not support frames, so if you are using the Password Protect to redirect to a web page on Bravenet Hosting, you will need to select the Popup option.

Show ad in a popup window (DEFAULT)

Show ad in a frame along the bottom of the screen

2. Logout Generator, the Logout Generator will create a text link that allows the user to logout, open the generator – [click here](#) and customize font family, size, color, decoration, style, and mouseover. Enter a logout URL, for example your home page or a logout confirmation page. Generate the code. This code can be pasted into the same HTML module as the Login Protect code.
